The regular meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on Monday, July 17, 2006 at the Derby Police Department, 125 Water Street, Derby.

The meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. By Chm. Hughes. Present were Commissioners Hughes, DiSorbo and Estwan. Also present were Chief Cota and Lt. Mascolo.

Acceptance of Minutes

A motion to accept the minutes of the June 12, 2006 meeting was made by Mr. DiSorbo and seconded by Mr. Estwan. It was noted that the word "none" should be removed after Traffic Authority Business. The motion was carried unanimously.

a. Harrison Ave. curb cut issue.

Chief Cota stated that when the curb cut is being done part of the road will be blocked. This will be a temporary blocking. It is a curb cut for a driveway for a single family home. There was some concern that people would be able to use this as a short cut but that will not be happening.

Chief Cota stated that the owner of the pizza parlor at 15 Minerva Street asked for a 15 minute parking space in front of the restaurant. He spoke with the Parking Authority and they were not in favor of this. There are more businesses coming into the area and there was a concern that this could set a precedent. The Commissioners were in agreement that the space should not be allowed.

There were some issues with parking at the Greenway entrance on Division Street and they are trying to work those out.

Old Business

Mr. Hughes asked about the officer of the year and Chief Cota stated that they are still working on that. He also stated that May is usually police awards month so that would probably be the best time to do this.

Department Reports

The Department report was not available for review.

A motion to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel and contract issues and to have Chief Cota and Lt. Mascolo attend was made by Mr. Estwan, seconded by Mr. Hughes and carried unanimously. The Board went into Executive Session at 6:25 p.m. and the regular meeting was adjourned after that.
